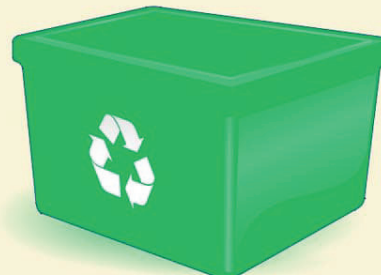

RECYCLING UPDATE

- **Beginning March 1**, Ramelli Janitorial will begin providing recycling and drop site services for the City of Kenner
- **All recycling pick-up days will remain the same**
- **All garbage pick-up days will remain the same** - IV Waste will continue to provide garbage collection services
- **Drop site hours of operation remain the same:** Sat. and Sun. 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.
- **All BLACK recycling cans are expected to be retrieved by IV Waste** during their routes on Feb. 23, 24 and 25.
- **Ramelli will begin delivering GREEN recycling bins** prior to the March 1 recycling transition date

RECYCLING UPDATE

Following our initial recycling update, we have heard from several residents and business owners that have concerns regarding the green recycling bins. As we have stated consistently, the transition to an alternative recycling contractor arises out of the City's best efforts to ensure **fiscal responsibility**, which we believe our constituents expect from their public servants.

However, due to the short notice from IV Waste that threatened to stop services unless we continued to pay their overbilling, the city was forced to create a quick solution. Utilizing the existing inventory of green recycle bins provided at no additional charge serves as a temporary solution to continue recycling services without being overcharged.

The City of Kenner is examining the possibility of obtaining containers similar to the rolling, covered recycling cans as we recognize the convenience that these cans offer.
